What is Fantasy Football?

Fantasy football is an online game where you become the manager of your own football team. There are various websites and apps you can play this game on, we will be using the official Barclays Premier League website/app. You have a budget of £100million and you need to pick 15 players from the English Premier League. Each week from your 15 players you pick a starting 11 and 4 substitutes. As the players from your team play in real life they gain points for your team for goals, assists, clean sheets etc. These points are totalled and will be displayed on our school league table.

Why are we running this club?

Due to the current situation many of our clubs are unable to run. This will provide an opportunity for the school community to engage with each other outside the classroom environment.

Keeping Pupils Safe Online

At St David's RC High School we know that it is vital for our pupils to be responsible and safe when using online platforms. If your child is planning to join this club then we recommend they take the following steps.

1. During registration the website asks for an email address. We recommend the pupils use their Glow email address. This email address is not displayed anywhere on the website.
2. During registration it asks for your full name. This is displayed on league tables beside the team name so we recommend pupils use their first name and their initial for their second. For example Joe B.
3. Pupils under the age of 13 will also need to provide a parent's email address for approval.
4. You will see on the website that there is two game types. We will be setting up a school league with a classic FPL league format. This format has no in game messaging service. If pupils choose to play other games on the website independently there may be in game chat features. We recommend that pupils do not do this without their parent/guardians permission and only join additional leagues with people that they know.
5. To register for this game you need to create a password. We recommend that pupils create a unique password different from any other that they use. We also recommend logging out whenever using a public device.
6. At this time we are not inviting parents/guardians to join this club. This will be for pupils and staff only.
